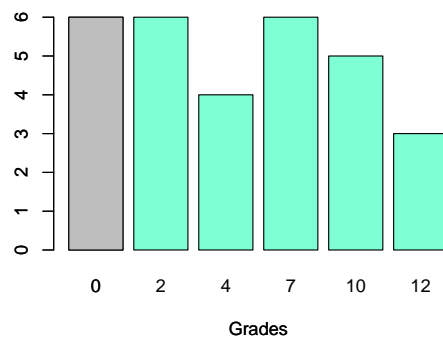
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DM544 - Computer Architecture (Computerarkitektur) **Action plan after students' evaluations**

At the beginning of the course the number of students registered in the BlackBoard system was 43. The course had one pass/fail obligatory assignment and a final oral exam with grade. The number of students registered to the obligatory assignment was 34. They all passed the obligatory assignment. At the oral exam, 4 did not show up and 6 failed. The distribution of grades is shown below.



After the course 14 students filled the evaluation form. From the evaluations it arises that:

- the majority of the students did not like the text book and consequently they did not like either the slides that were taken from the book
- nine of the respondents were unsatisfied with the pedagogical competencies of the teacher
- eight students found that the workload was too high
- five students had difficulty understanding the teacher talking in

English

It was the first time that I taught this course and I will not teach the course in the next edition. I agree with the students that the text should be changed and that the lectures should be made more entertaining and engaging. I know the next teacher has already decided to use another text book and that the course will have a different organization. On the personal side I will try to improve my English pronunciation and put more attention on the pedagogical aspects of teaching.
